

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Rapeepun Vanichviriyakit Mahidol University, Thailand

Dr. Rapeepun Vanichviriyakit is now the Director of Center of Excellence for Shrimp Molecular Biology and Biotechnology (Centex Shrimp), Faculty of Science, Mahidol University, Thailand. The Centex Shrimp serves as a coordination center for cooperative research on shrimp amongst Mahidol University, BIOTEC (NSTDA, Thailand), shrimp industry, and other national and international institutions.

Dr. Rapeepun Vanichviriyakit graduated with her Ph.D. in Anatomy from Mahidol University, Thailand, in 2007. She gained her research experience in reproductive biology for ~2 years in Prof. Nongnuch Tanpaichitr's lab, OHRI, Canada. After that, she began working in the shrimp reproduction and disease-associated histopathology research field. She is now an Associate Professor at Mahidol University, teaching undergraduate and postgraduate courses, including an annual international training course for shrimp histopathology, and supervising many M.Sc. and Ph.D. students. In addition, she has been an Editorial Advisory Board of the Journal of Fish Disease (©John Wiley & Sons Ltd) since 2021.
