Eric joined United States Pharmacopeia (USP) and Food Chemicals Codex (FCC) in March of 2020. He serves as a scientific liaison between the USP Food Ingredients Expert Committee (FIEC) and FCC staff to usher standards through the standard setting process. He also serves as coordinator of the Foods lab projects and staff lead to the FCC Dietary Proteins Expert Panel. Prior to working at FCC, Eric worked as a Senior Scientist at the Flavor Research and Education Center (FREC) at the Ohio State University Department of Food Science and Technology where his research involved method development, isolation, and characterization of flavor active compounds. Eric received his doctorate degree in medicinal chemistry and pharmacognosy at the Ohio State University where his research was focused on the synthesis and optimization of bioactive natural products.
