Dr. Liu Xin, currently a professor at Wuhan Polytechnic University's School of Food Science and Engineering, specializes in Environmental Pollution and Food Safety. His academic tenure includes a Ph.D. collaboration between the National Food Safety Risk Assessment Center and Nanchang University (2016-2018), followed by a visiting scientist role at the University of Ottawa (2018-2019). Dr. Xin's research focuses on identifying new food risk factors, environmental contamination analysis, and exposure and health risk assessments. He has led key projects under the National Key Research and Development Program of China and the National Natural Science Foundation of China, exploring efficient risk identification and control in the new food chain with microalgin. His professional engagements include serving on the Youth Committee of the Professional Committee on Analytical Toxicology, Chinese Society of Toxicology, and editorial roles in reputable scientific journals.
